# Welcome to your job on one of Sweden's livestock farms!

*Sweden is free from many serious infectious animal diseases such as foot and mouth disease, swine fever and PRRS. Because people can spread infection, we want to tell you some simple but important rules for working with Swedish livestock.*



## 48 hour rule

After visiting livestock abroad, wait two full days before working with animals in Sweden



## Wait five days

Wait five full days after visiting livestock in a country that is not free from foot and mouth disease



## No food waste

Never give the animals food waste



## Wash your hands

Always wash your hands before working in the shed



## Clothing

Use the farm's own work clothes and shoes or boots
